Obedient private
Massachusetts line 3 yrs
In the army of the United States during the Revolutionary War

Inscribed on the Roll of Maine
at the rate of 8 Dollars per month, to commence on
the 18th of April 1818.

and sent to Vudak Dana Esq^r.
Fryeburg Maine

Commonwealth of Massachusetts. a citizen of the United States do
testify and declare on oath that I served in the war of
the revolution against the Common Enemy, as a Privated
during in the Continental Establishment. about three years
I enlisted ^{in Massachusetts} the first of the year 1777 for three years
into Capt. Whulwright's company - Col^l Francis Rejouis
in Putnam's Brigade Massachusetts Line. I served out the
time excepting about one week & then enlisted during
the war - I served about two years of said last mentioned time
and was taken sick and had a furlow - and I did not
recover my health so as to return until the army was
disbanded - I further say that I am a Resident of the United
States & that from my reduced circumstances in life I am
in need of assistance from my country for support -
